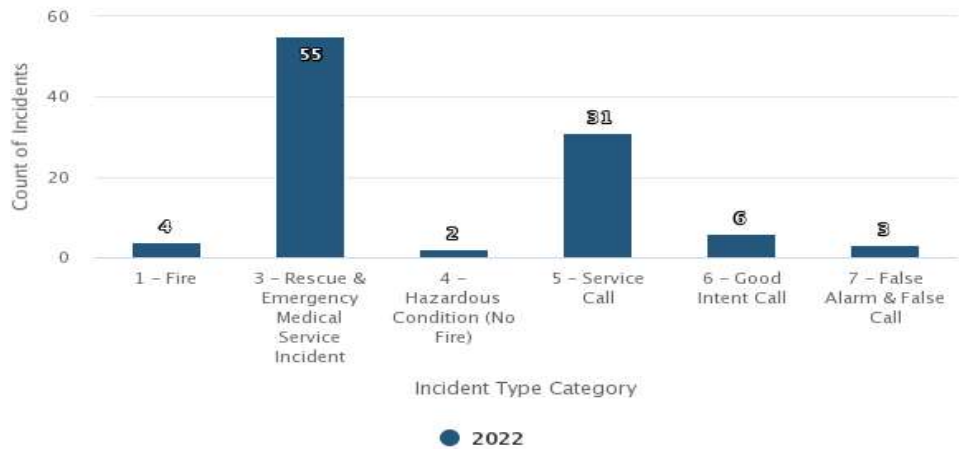

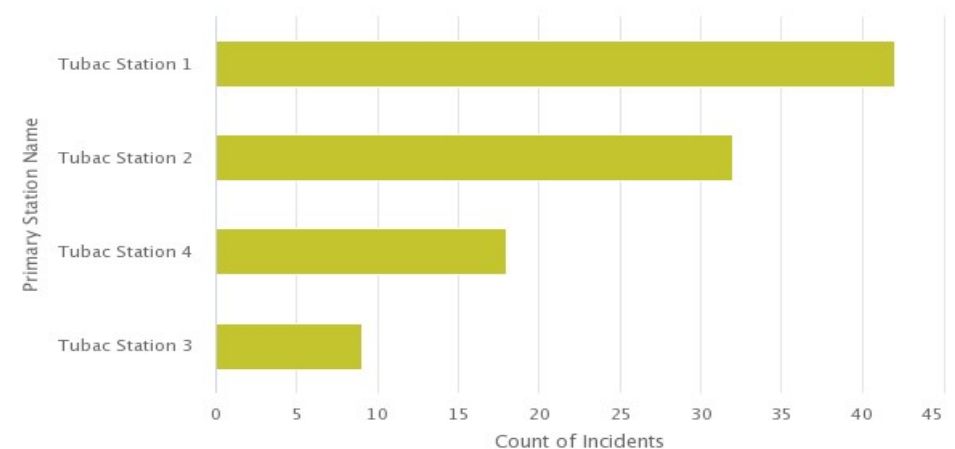
Incidents by Category and Year

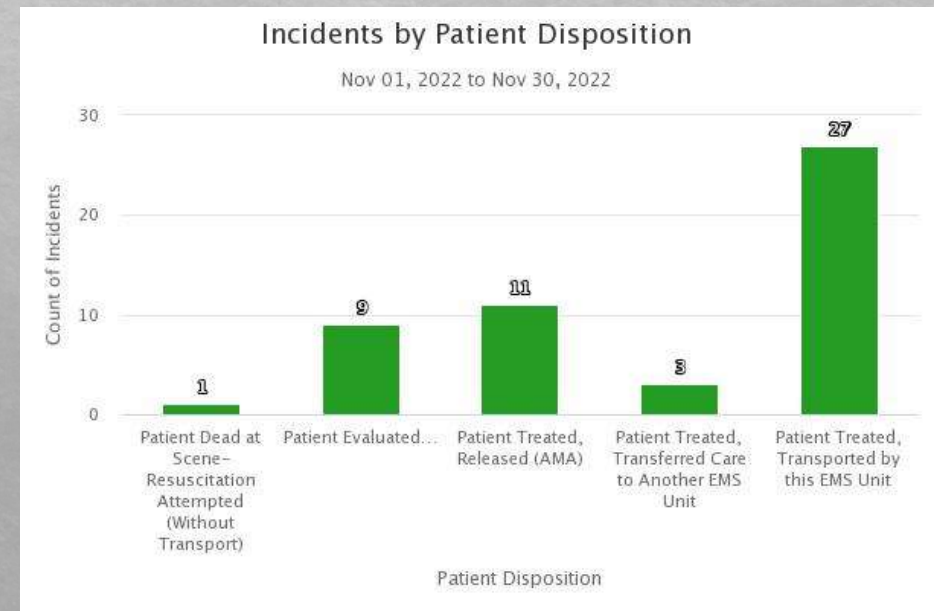

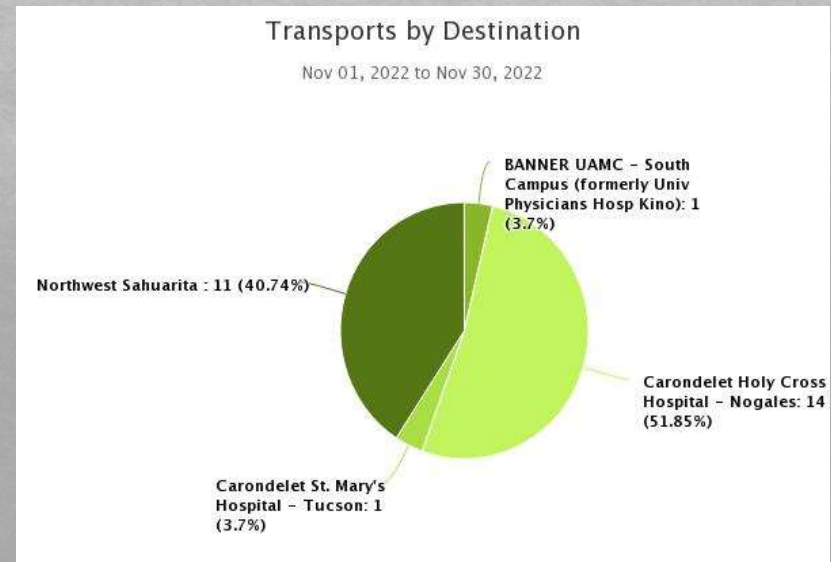

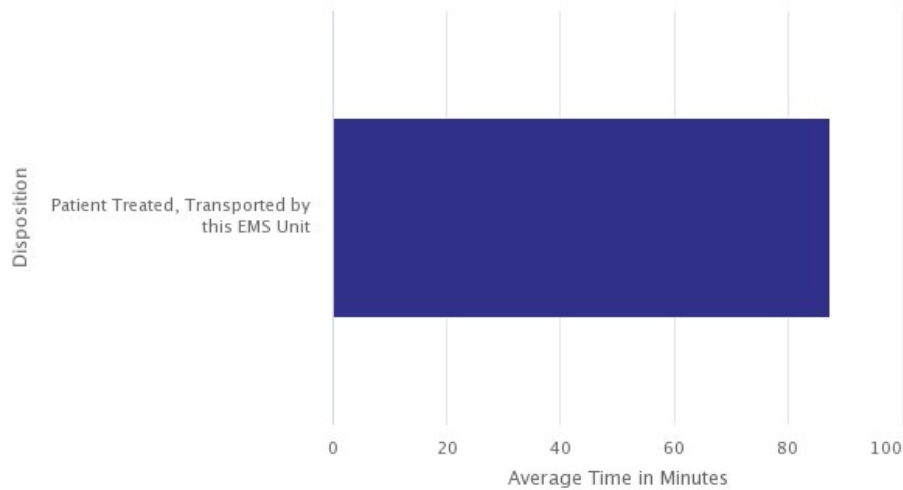
A Shift 28

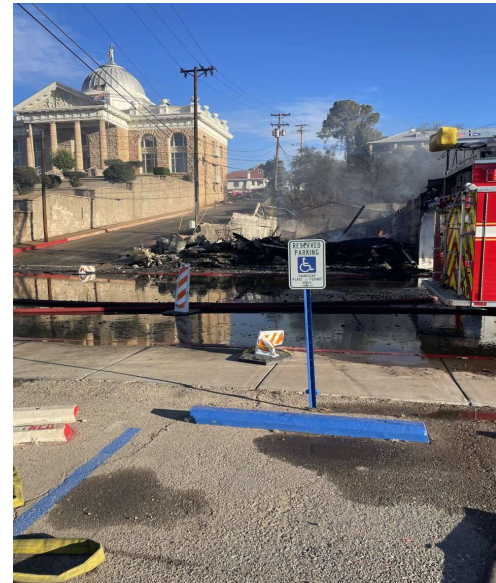
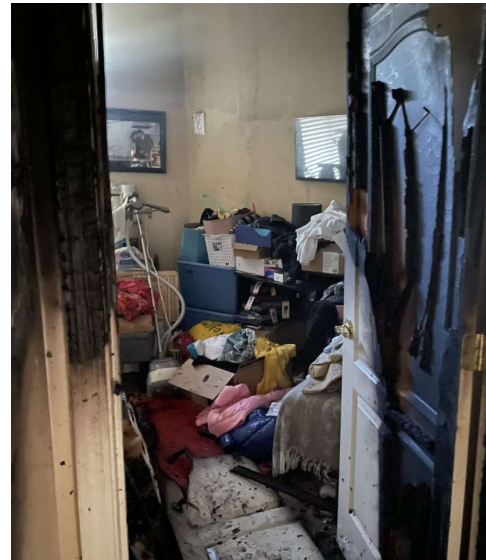
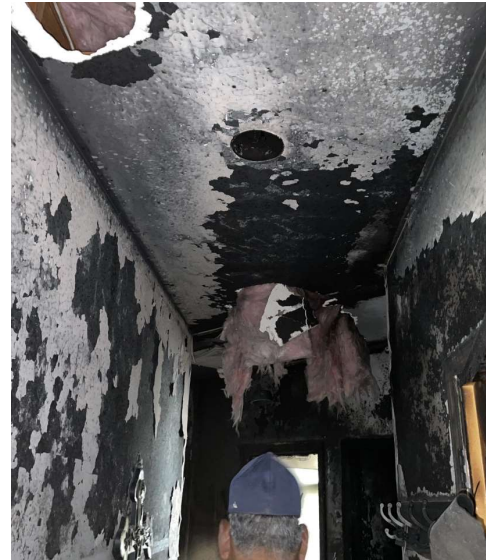

Significant calls

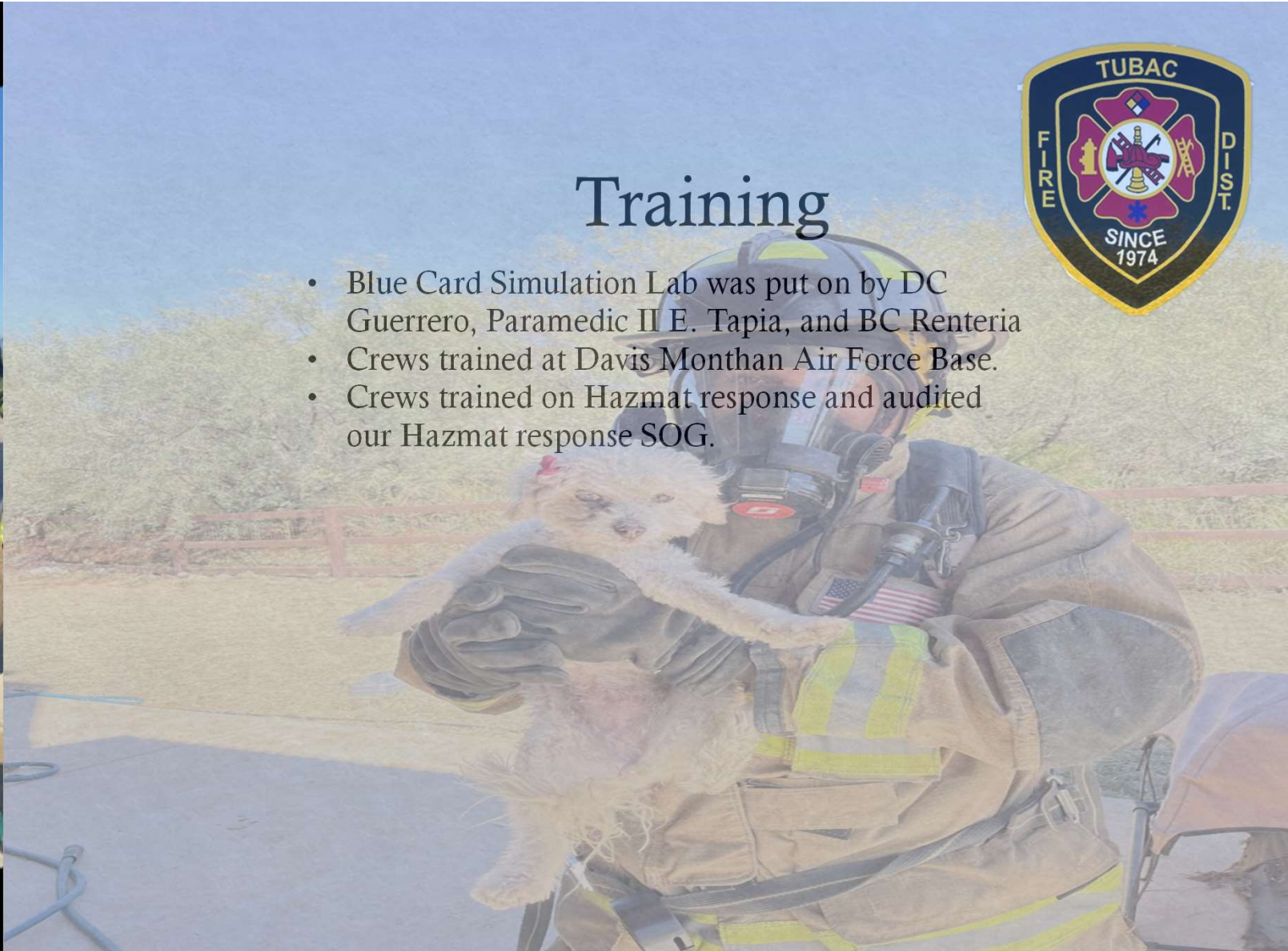
- ◆ November 6th structure fire, Adorn Ct. Crews knocked down the fire immediately and kept it to room in contents.

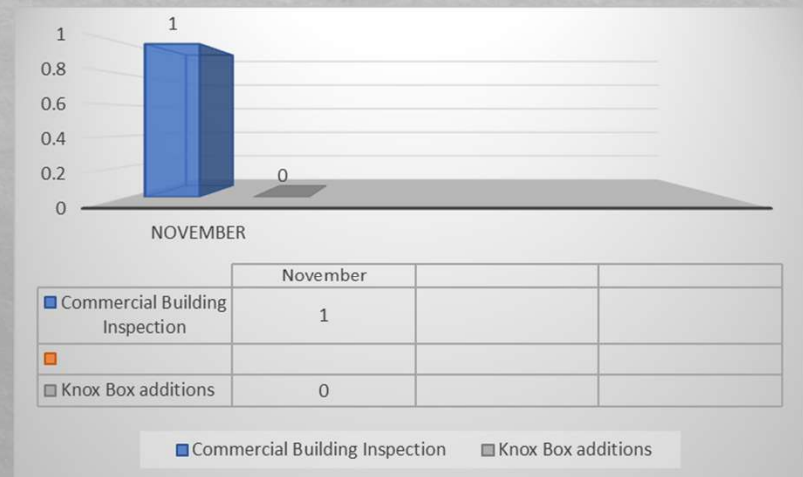
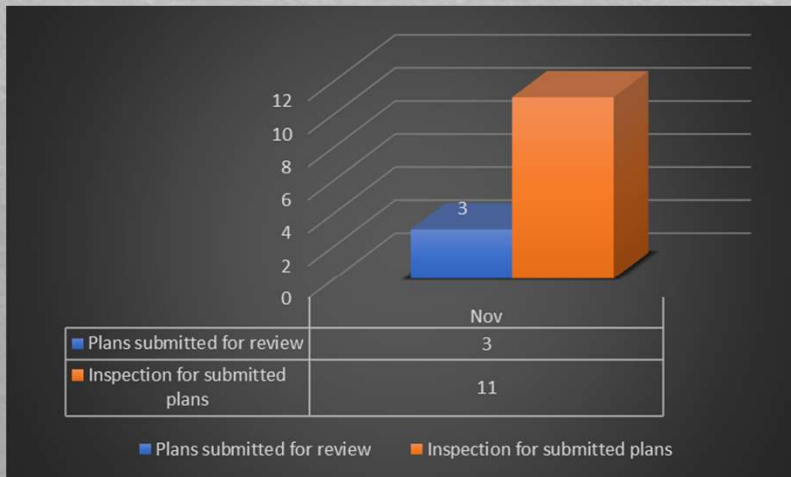


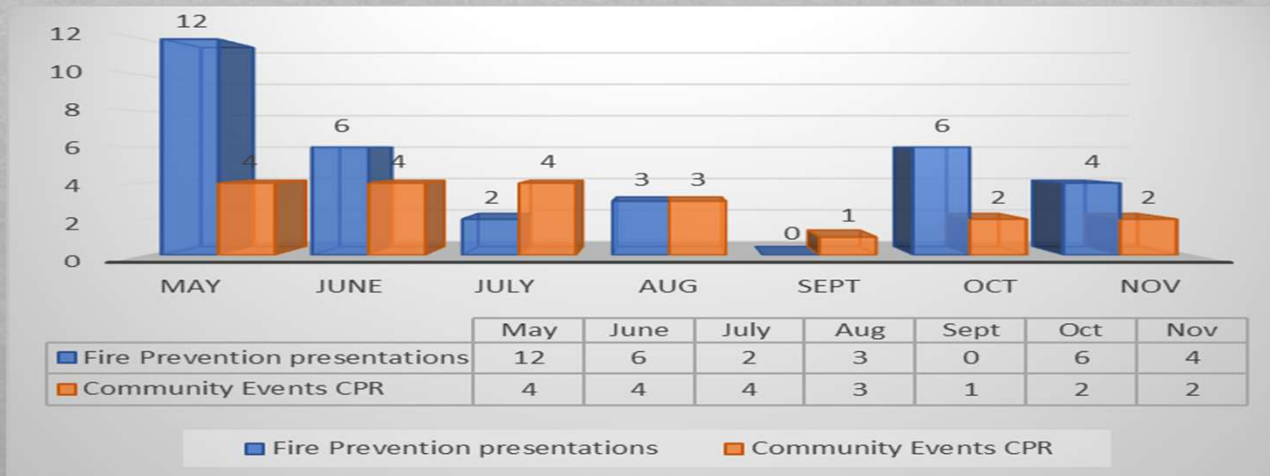
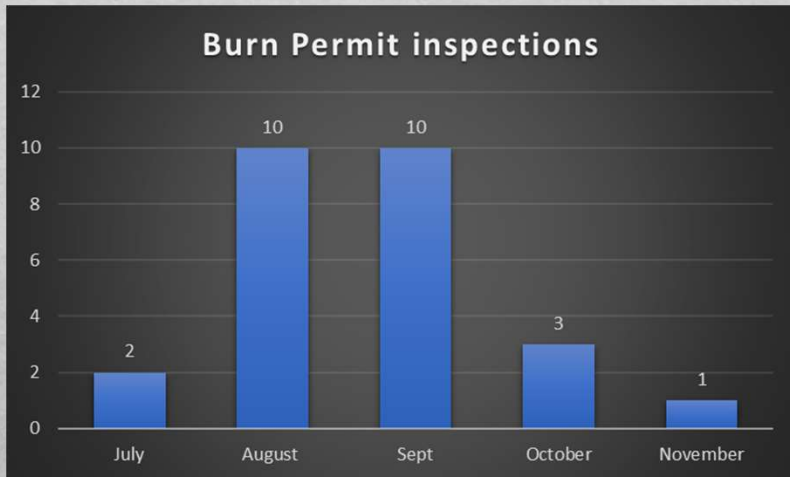


Training

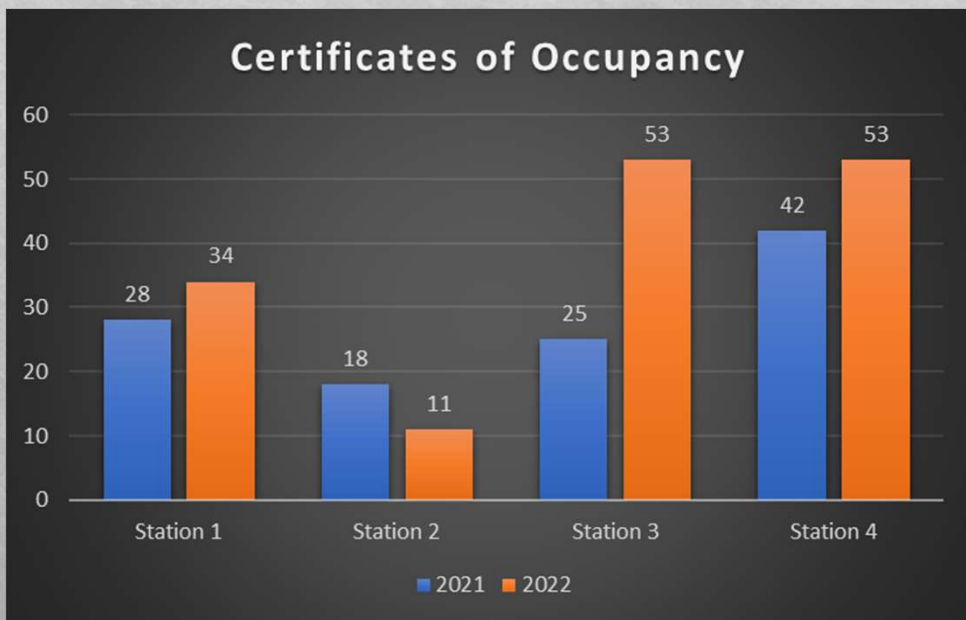
- Blue Card Simulation Lab was put on by DC Guerrero, Paramedic II E. Tapia, and BC Renteria

- Crews trained on Hazmat response and audited our Hazmat response SOG.



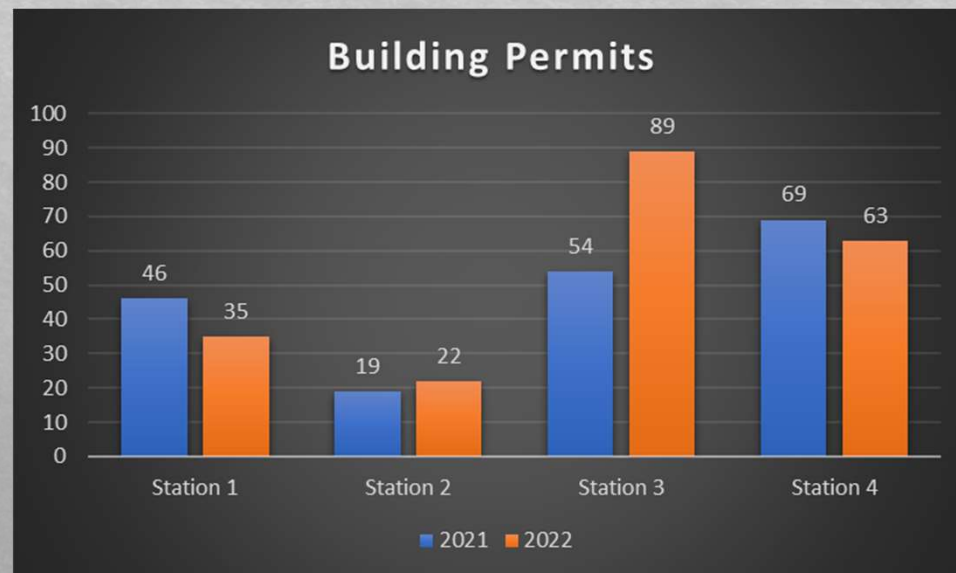
